

Higher Education Grants Scheme 2007

Date Issued: 13th July 2007

Clare County Council shall award grants for Higher Education to eligible candidates in accordance with the provisions of the Local Authorities (Higher Education Grants) Acts 1968 to 1992 and the terms of the above Scheme.

Since 1996, the Scheme has been extended to include both students already studying abroad and new entrants on approved courses at Undergraduate level in an EU member state other than Ireland or Northern Ireland. Grants are payable subject to the applicant satisfying a means test.

The Scheme and Application Forms (with completion notes) can be obtained by calling to the Offices of the Council during the hours mentioned below or by forwarding an A4 size stamped self-addressed envelope (€1.30) to the **Higher Education Grants Section, Clare County Council, Information Age Park Ennis, Gort Road, Ennis, Co. Clare.**
