Also a walk in Moyode woods outside of Craughwell was organised on Saturday 19th September. **Seán Ó Flannagáin** was out again to give a guided talk '*as Gaeilge*' through the forest. Families were given a special welcome as the were guided through the wealth of nature during the afternoon stroll. The gathering learnt quite a lot about all things bright and beautiful from the smallest to the biggest, from the forest floor to the tops of the trees.
