Following the success of Aughty People and Earth Day held in Crusheen last year, Kilchreest Castledaly Heritage Group are this year hosting an “Aughty Gathering” of all those interested in the heritage of the Sliabh Aughty area. Sliabh Aughty extends from Loughrea south to Mountshannon and from Crusheen east to Portumna.

The purpose of the day is to bring together people who are active or interested in local heritage in the Sliabh Aughty region of Counties Clare and Galway and to introduce themselves to each other. The day will provide a unique opportunity to share heritage interests in a cross county inclusive way and identify possible future projects. The day will be completely informal.

The event will take place on Saturday 21st April in the Castle Inn Castledaly commencing at 10.00am and concluding at 5.30pm. Castledaly is eight miles from Loughrea and seven miles from Gort on the main Loughrea / Gort road. Refreshments will be served during the day.

The keynote address will be given by the geographer Fidelma Mullane who specialises in Vernacular Architecture.

Throughout the day there will be small group workshops on topics such as Music, Folklore, Customs, Place Names, Big Houses, Wildlife, Family History, Forestry, Irish Language, Churches, Graveyards, Walkways, Schools on the Sliabh Aughty, Children’s Burial Grounds, Trades, Old Cures, Stone Walls, Holy Wells.

Those present will select their chosen themes and Anne O’Doherty, Crusheen, will act as facilitator for the day.
