Gaeilge Locha Riach and **Elaine O'Ríordáin**, Co. Galway Biodiversity Officer would like to invite the general public of East Galway to attend a special presentation on placenames in Naomh Breandán Credit Union, Loughrea on Monday 12th October @ 8.00 p.m.

Tamás Peterváry, archaeologist, will give an insight into the placenames of the area with a particular emphasis on the names that are derived from nature. The main aim of this evening is to clarify an understanding of placenames and to give local people the opportunity to get to know the nature of their own area that little bit better.

The powerpoint presentation will be divided under various natural themes; e.g. plants / insects / animals etc.

It is intended that such a presentation will encourage further discussion on the understanding of placenames and on the origin and folklore of these names. Hopefully such a meeting will create a further interest in the meanings of placenames and perhaps the use of the Gaeilge version of the townlands will also be encouraged.
