Clare Lifelong Learning Network is a project funded by the European social fund under the Equal Initiative. It is a network of more than 70 Adult and Community Education providers in County Clare.

The aim of the project is to develop a model of working in partnership so that adult learners will have access to comprehensive, quality learning opportunities, with clearly recognisable progression pathways.

ICT has been used as a tool to facilitate communications, management and learning.
