The competition focus is on people coming together to shape, change and enjoy all that is good about their area. In Pride of Place, community groups have the opportunity to showcase specific pride initiatives which will have long lasting and positive impacts on their society.

### **How your community can take part?**

The Council may nominate up to a maximum of **five** community groups. **One group only** may be entered in any population category, but multiple entries are allowed in the “single issue” project category providing the total number nominated in all categories does not exceed five. The selected category winners will then be put forward for entry to the Co-operation Ireland National Pride of Place competition – full details available on or <http://prideofplace.cooperationireland.org>

### **Categories for the Competition:**

- Category 1 - population up to 200 persons**
- Category 2 - population between 200 and 500 persons**
- Category 3 - population between 500 and 1000 persons**
- Category 4- population between 1000 and 2000 persons**
- Category 5- population between 2000 and 5000 persons**
- Category 6- population over 5000 persons**
- Category 7- Single Issue Project**
